I. Statement of Policy

The Self Defence Centre CIC offers an open and transparent training facility in line with the required Awarding organisations policies and procedures.

The Self Defence Centre CIC all possible safeguards to ensure that where foreseeable any risk of adverse effects will be identified and controlled to the necessary required level.

II. Definition of an 'Adverse Effect'

For the purpose of this policy, an 'adverse effect' is defined as:

Safeguards

To eliminate or reduce the risk of such an adverse effect, please note that:

1. **The Self Defence Centre CIC** no outstanding debts or loans against the company.
2. **The Self Defence Centre CIC** and regular financial cash flow, which can be evidenced by our audited accounts.
3. We would liaise with our AO regional manager and will advise of any risk of certification so that learners can be transferred to another AO centre.
4. All learner documentation is now scanned and held on A3 secure server sites which is regularly backed up on and off-line so that learner documentation would never be lost.
5. As soon as courses are completed certification is claimed straight away and all invoices are settled immediately upon presentation.
